



Disneyland Childcare Program

Beginning in fall 2019, the Disneyland Resort will make a commitment of \$10 million annually, which can fluctuate based on usage, to help reduce the costs of childcare expenses for our working parents. This significant enhancement is in addition to the existing childcare programs: back up care, childcare referral assistance and center discounts, homework help, as well as a variety of parenting educational resources.

Who is eligible?

Full- and part-time hourly and salaried Cast who work for the Disneyland Resort and offsite locations.



Cast who have children ages 12 and under will have the ability to apply for the program



Cast will have the ability to select from a variety of licensed childcare facilities in multiple locations



After completing an application process, Cast will be informed of the financial assistance that Disney will pay on behalf of the Cast Member's children. Payments for childcare will be made directly to the childcare provider, no reimbursement or receipts will be required.



The amount of the financial assistance for each child is determined by a variety of factors including household size, gross annual household income and space availability in program.
