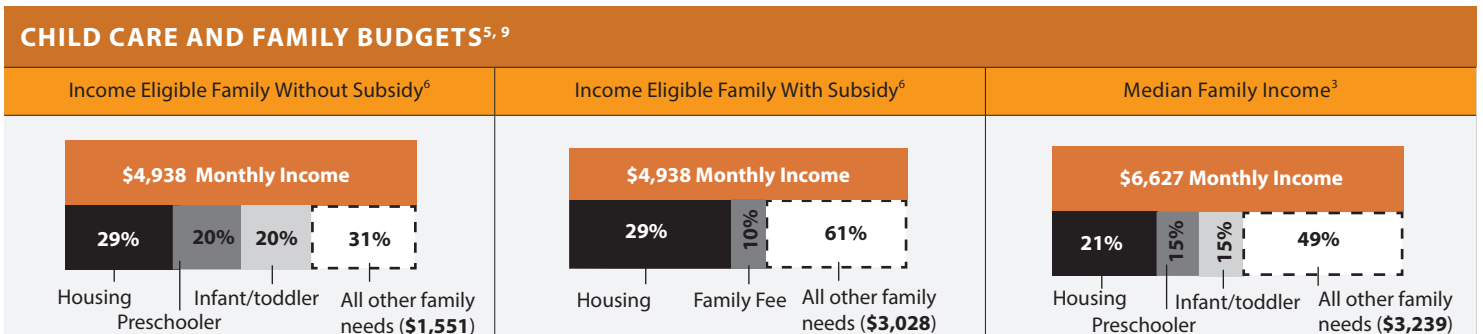
Family & Child Data
