

Fast Facts about Licensing

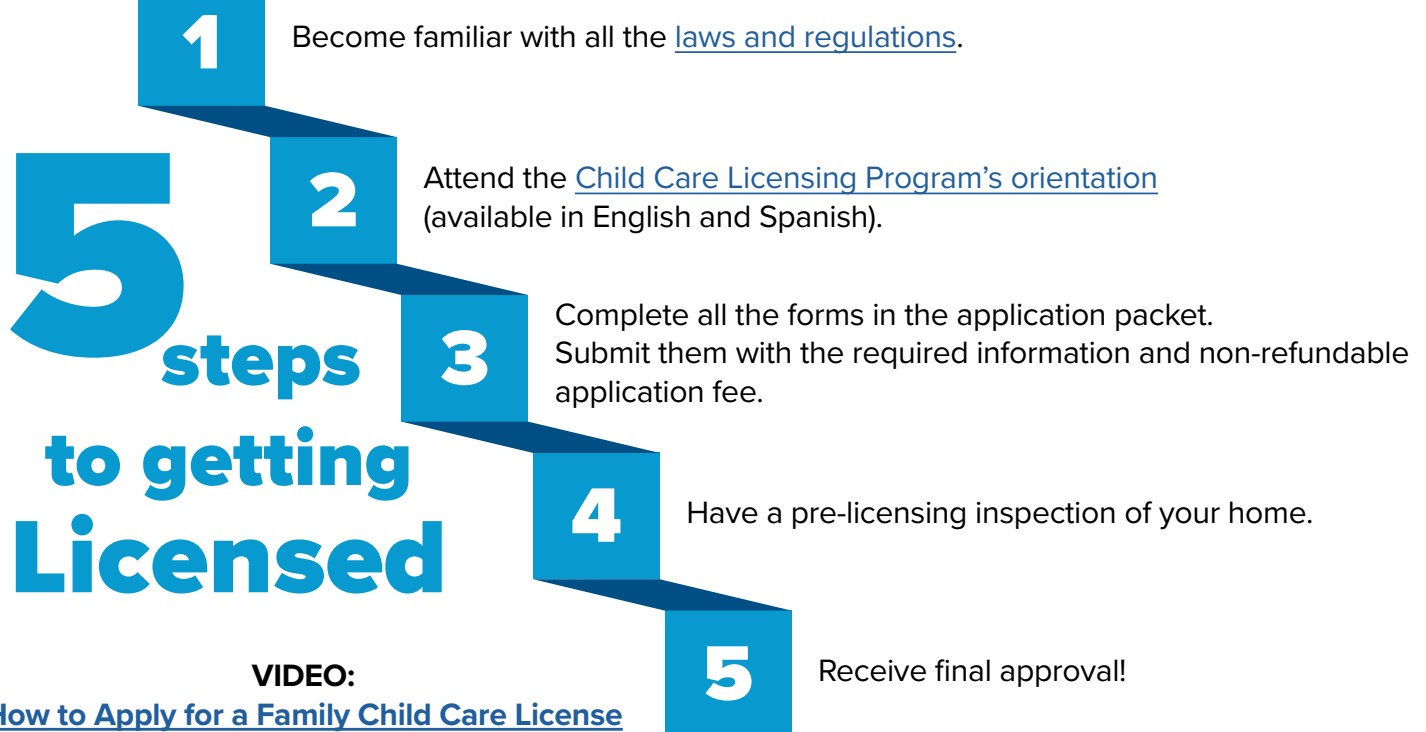
In California, you need a license if you care for children from more than one family and are not related to those children. If you care for your own children and children from one other family, you don't need a license.

Any home-based child care provider, who is interested, can become a licensed Family Child Care Home.



Do you meet the requirements for getting a Family Child Care Home license? Requirements include:

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must care for children in your own home
- Criminal record clearance
- TB test
- 16 hours of health & safety training
